Care workers walk a close and committed road with families in need, who are mostly affected or infected by HIV/AIDS and of which many are suffering from dire poverty.

The program has a strong parenting skill training focus and the care workers assist the families with practical things such as a birth registration and ID documents. This enables them to receive their Government Grant. The project work to make families strong and so prevent disintegration, and children being left abandoned.

Cluster care impacts more than 1700 beneficiaries directly.
